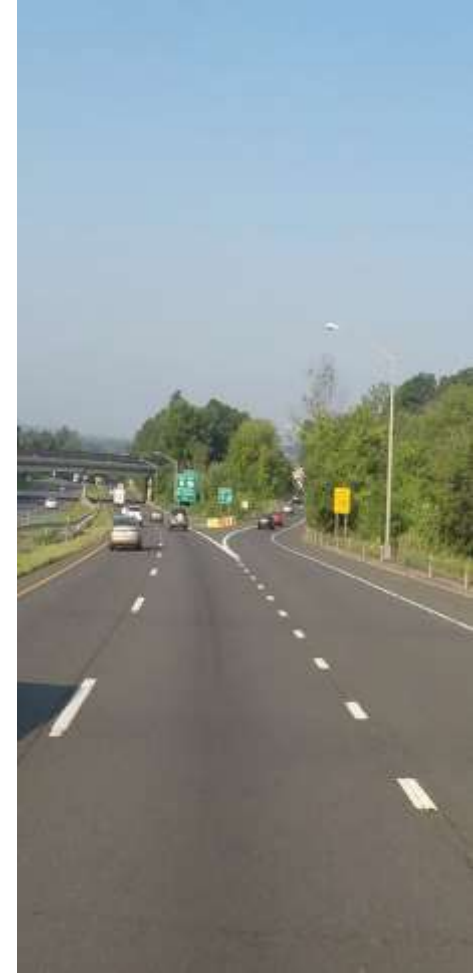


# Why Improve I-84 in Danbury?

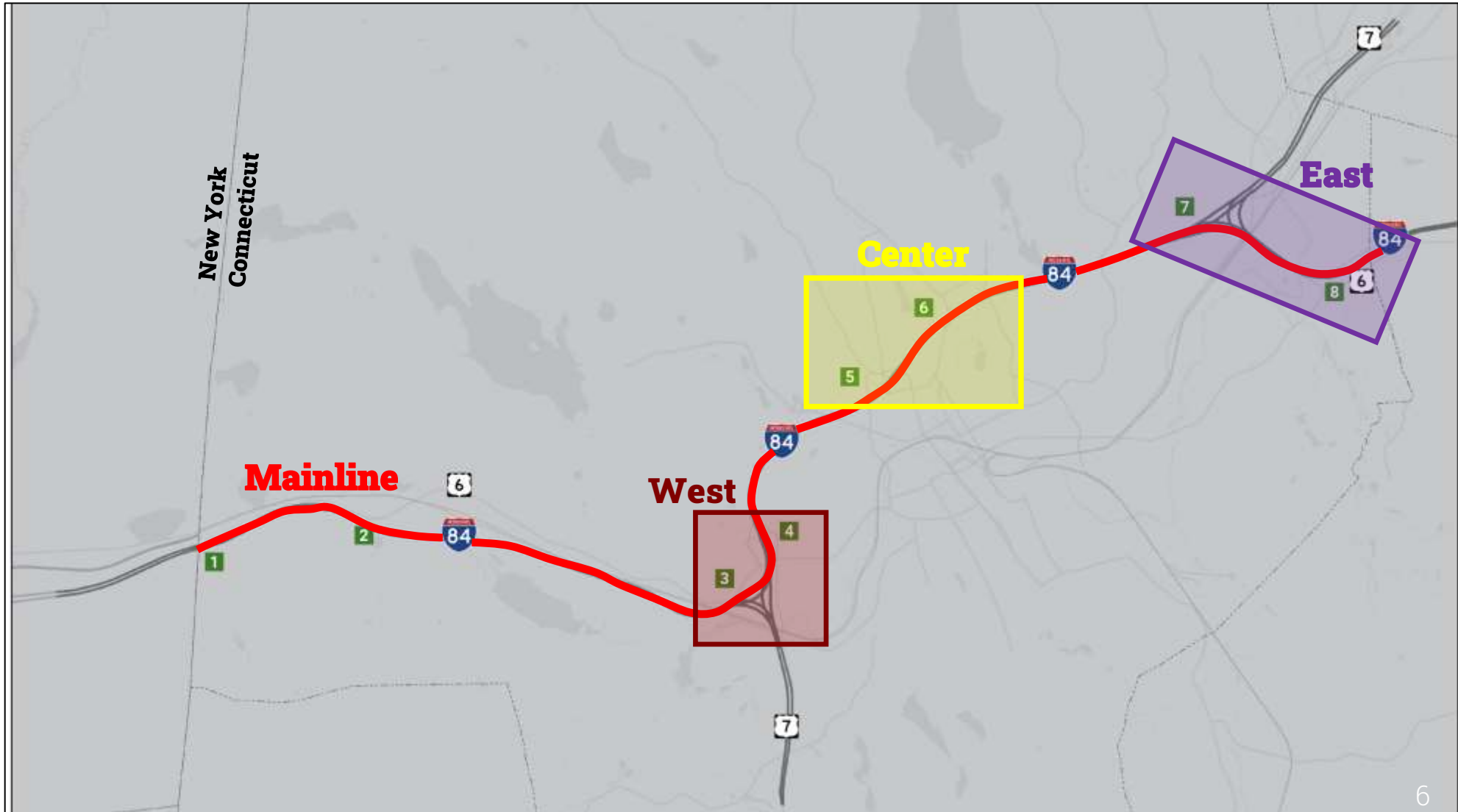


# Draft Purpose Statement

**Concept 1**



Concept 1 seeks to create lane continuity, eliminate left-hand exit ramps, and, where possible, improve horizontal curvature and vertical geometry. This concept endeavors to maintain the current alignment of I-84 and stay within the existing right-of-way to the greatest extent possible.

**Concept 2**



Concept 2 seeks to improve congestion and mobility by constructing eastbound and westbound collector distributor (CD) roads in the center section of the corridor.

Concept 3 seeks to improve access to Danbury Hospital and Downtown through a series of improvements in the center section of the corridor. There are six variations of Concept 3, named C3-1 through C3-6.

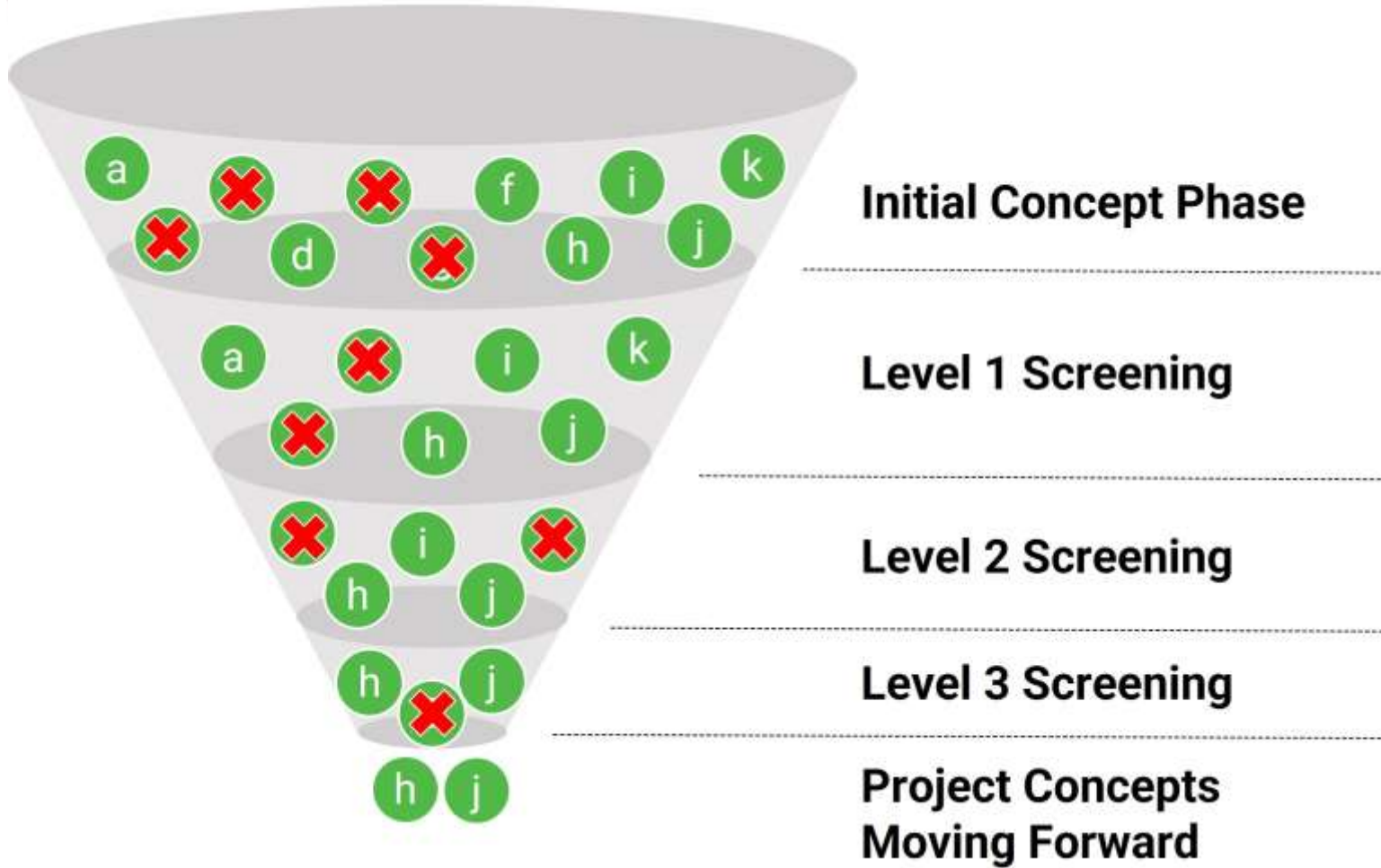
