Study Limits








Why Improve I-84 in Danbury?


Draft Purpose Statement

Concept 1 Concept 1 seeks to create lane

continuity, eliminate left-hand exit ramps, and, where possible improve horizontal curvature and vertical geometry. This concept endeavors to maintain the current alignment of I-84 and stay within the existing right-of-way to the greatest extent possible.

Concept 2 seeks to improve congestion and mobility by constructing eastbound and westbound collector distributor of the corridor.



 - Complex projects would likely take 10+ years for implementation
