The purpose of these meetings is to provide the community with the opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. The in-person meeting will begin as an open house, with a formal presentation following. The virtual meeting will include a presentation, and a Q&A session will immediately follow.

The purpose of this project is to reduce congestion and improve mobility on I-84, Route 7, and the adjacent roadway network. This project focuses on operational improvements and enhancing reliability, capacity, and operations in the I-84 corridor during congested periods. The proposed improvements are anticipated to improve safety by reducing congestion-related crashes.

Construction is expected to start in summer 2028, depending on funding and permits. The estimated cost is \$250 million, with 90% federal funds and 10% state funds. Right-of-way impacts are not anticipated.
