

I-84 Flex Lane


Project Purpose & Need



**Reduce congestion and improve mobility
on I-84, Route 7, and adjacent roadways**



Project Limits



Note: Project limits (in orange) extend past the Flex Lane limits.

How will a Flex Lane address this need?

By repurposing the median shoulder into a **temporary travel lane** during the busiest times to improve traffic flow and safety



This *proven* FHWA strategy:



Improves traffic flow



Provides more capacity during rush hours



Increases reliability



Reduces the number of congestion-related crashes











ROUTE 7 SOUTHBOUND/I-84 WESTBOUND







What would the Flex Lane look like?





New Camera Infrastructure

Full camera coverage of the Flex Lane and general-purpose lanes

- Check for lane obstructions in Flex Lane
 - Debris
 - Weather related
- Confirm congestion/incidents across all lanes





Westbound I-84 (Toward New York)


Existing Route 7 Southbound

Noise Analysis Process



Measure Existing Noise Conditions

Noise monitoring was conducted in November 2025



Validate Traffic Noise Model

Calculate existing and future noise levels



Identify Noise Impacts

Identify predicted noise impacts



Consider Noise Abatement Measures

If impacted, determine if abatement/noise walls are feasible and reasonable

Project Classification: Type I




Includes, but is not limited to, new highways, added lanes, or substantial horizontal or vertical alignment changes
(per 23 CFR 772 & CTDOT's Noise Policy)

\$ The estimated construction cost for the project is \$250M.

Flex Lane Construction


- ✓ New overhead gantries

- ✓ Isolated bridge median and parapet improvements



State of Good Repair Investments

- ✓ Median reconstruction
- ✓ Drainage & guiderail upgrades
- ✓ Illumination and signage upgrades
- ✓ Routine pavement preservation & improvements
- ✓ Wrong-way detection systems
